Scholarship Thank You Letter – Viridiana Sotelo Pérez

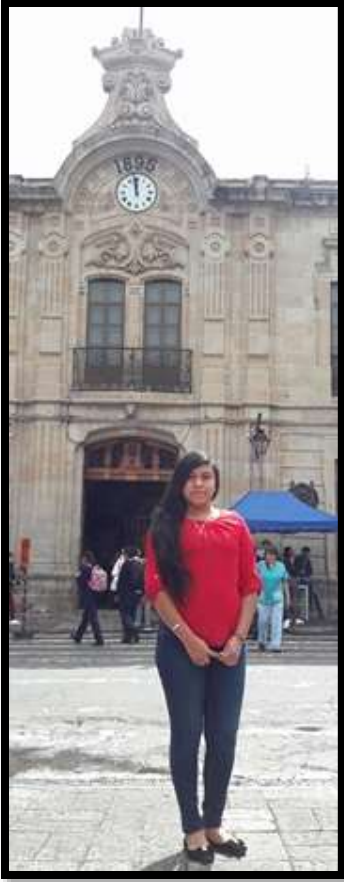
